> Prohibits making pornographic or sexually explicit content accessible to minors via online platforms.

2. Strafgesetzbuch (StGB) - German Criminal Code

§ 184 StGB - Verbreitung pornographischer Schriften

Criminalizes the distribution, public display, or broadcasting of pornographic material, including online uploads.

> Punishable by fines or imprisonment up to one year (or up to three years in aggravated cases).

3. Telemediengesetz (TMG) - Telemedia Act

§ 10 TMG - Responsibility of Service Providers

> Platforms like Facebook are responsible for removing illegal content once they become aware of it.

➤ Failure to act can lead to liability.
